
The Law Foundation of Prince Edward Island provides grant support for the following areas:

The Law Foundation of PEI has provided \$1,738,932 in grants over the last five years (2011--2015). The annual dollar amounts vary with interest rate fluctuations and the amount of funds available to the Foundation for distribution. Some grants awarded are for single or multi-year projects while others are for continuous programs.

PEI Human Rights Commission

Collaborative Law

Funds provided for research related to resolving disputes through an interdisciplinary collaborative process serving low-income families involved in high-conflict situations.

East Coast Environmental Law

Funding was provided to conduct an environmental law workshop and to produce a summary publication each year. In 2011, it was entitled *Environmental Assessment: Legal Toolkit*, and in 2010, *The Coast*.

Provided seed funding to research and develop a parenting coordination program that fits into the PEI context for high conflict families before the Family Court in contested child custody matters.

Family Legal Aid Lawyer

A seven-year agreement (total commitment of \$590,000) with PEI Legal Aid was reached to support an additional family legal aid lawyer position in the Summerside office. The contributions began in 2008 (\$75,000) and include an increase of \$3000 for each year of the agreement. In 2015 a one-year extension was made to this agreement in the amount of \$75,000.
